

Mother and baby killed in collision

A DUBLIN woman and her six month-old baby daughter were killed last night when their car was in collision with an articulated truck on a straight stretch of road between Lucan and Leixlip.

She was Mrs. Patricia Culbert, Ardfield House, Lucan. Her husband, Liam, who was driving, was taken to the Meath Hospital. The baby, Michelle, was in a cot in the back of the car. Mrs. Culbert was also pregnant.

Neither the lorry driver, Mr. William Connolly (30), of O'Donoghue Avenue, Inchicore, nor his helper, John McGrath (17) of Railway Avenue, Inchicore, were injured.

Three years ago, two youths were killed at the same spot when their motor-cycle collided with a lorry.
